SUNNYVALE, CA (March 21, 2021) - Sunnyvale Community Players is thrilled to close our 53rd season with the Broadway gem, Lerner and Loewe's **CAMELOT**. The legendary love triangle of King Arthur, Guenevere and Sir Lancelot leaps from the pages of T.H. White's novel in Lerner and Loewe's award-winning, soaring musical. Borrowing from the Arthurian legends, *Lerner and Loewe's Camelot* is the duo's fantastical masterpiece which triumphed on Broadway in a legendary original production that led to a film version, and numerous revivals in New York, London and across the globe. Its Original Broadway Cast Album topped the charts for 60 weeks, with a rich score boasting such gems as "If Ever I Would Leave You," "I Loved You Once in Silence," "The Lusty Month of May," and of course, "Camelot." An idealistic young King Arthur hopes to create a kingdom built on honor and dignity, embodied by his Knights of The Round Table.
