**SUNNYVALE, CA (February 7th, 2023)** - Sunnyvale Community Players (SCP) continues our 54th season with ***Beauty and the Beast***. Step into the enchanted world of Broadway's classic, Disney's *Beauty and the Beast*, an international sensation that has been produced in 37 countries worldwide. Based on the Academy Award-winning animated feature, the stage version includes all of the wonderful songs written by Alan Menken and the late Howard Ashman, along with new songs by Mr. Menken and Tim Rice. The original Broadway production ran for over thirteen years and was nominated for nine Tony Awards, including Best Musical.

A singing teapot, a dancing candlestick, and a hairy beast all walk into a theater. The classic story tells of Belle, a young woman in a provincial town, and the Beast, who is really a young prince trapped under the spell of an enchantress. If the Beast can learn to love and be loved, the curse will end and he will be transformed into his former self. But time is running out. If the Beast does not learn his lesson soon, he and his household will be doomed for all eternity.

*Beauty and the Beast*, a junior production, opens on Friday, February 24, 2023, and runs through Sunday, March 12, 2023. Fridays at 7:30 p.m., Saturdays at 2:30 p.m and 7:30 p.m., Sundays at 2:30 p.m. Running time is approximately 2 and a half hours, plus intermission. Ticket prices are \$40 for adults, \$20 for children, and \$34 for seniors (60+) and for students.
